RainTube Wins Innovation Award from Urban Re:Vision—will be designed into prototype sustainable urban space

Jacksonville, OR, November 4, 2008: GLI Systems Inc. of Jacksonville, Oregon, manufacturer of RainTube hyper-green rain water control products, received a Notable Entry Award in one of eight categories of the Urban Re:Visions--Re:Construct competition. The Award was announced at West Coast Green a green building conference held in San Jose, CA on September 25, 2008.

RainTube was selected from a large field of international contestants who submitted innovation ideas to help reinvent the construction of urban communities. Awards were delivered by a panel of five prominent and distinguished judges from the architectural community.
